SANTA MONICA COLLEGE JAPAN STUDY ABROAD SUMMER 2020



- Tokyo Summer 2020: A unique opportunity for SMC students to study Japanese and business or education in Japan and engage in projects at Temple University, Japan or Bunkyo Gakuin University.
- Prior to the 2020 Olympics, during three weeks in the 6-week Summer 2020 intersession, SMC students will explore Japan in a program led by Prof. Yukiko Tsuboi.
- SMC students in this program will enroll in a Japanese 8 (Conversational Japanese 2 units), Japanese 99 (Experiential Learning 1 unit, and a hybrid ECE 11 (Child, Family, and Community 3 units) for a total of 6 units, OR Japanese 8 (Conversational Japanese 2 units), Japanese 99 (Experiential Learning 1 unit, and an online Business 30 (Customer Relationship Management 3 units) for a total of 6 units.
- The Japanese classes will also be held on campus during week one, and in Japan during weeks 2-4.
- ECE 11 will be held on campus during week one, and online during weeks 2-6.
- Business 30 will be online during weeks 1-6.

- Students will reside in student residence halls for most of their stay in Japan but will spend a weekend with a Japanese family.
- Students enrolled in the business class will be mentored by Temple University, Japan internship students.
- This study abroad program will include field trips to various sites in Japan.
- (Approximate cost: \$4,500 including airfare, room, breakfast and dinner, and insurance. Recommendations will be provided regarding financial aid and fundraising. Tuition, fees and books not included in approximate cost.)
- Intermediate proficiency in Japanese required by Summer 2020.
- This is a great opportunity to enhance your CV and discover a new career pathway.
