

Guidelines of Activities that <u>DO NOT QUALIFY</u> as INDIVIDUAL Professional Development /FLEX Activities

Please note that the following activities **CANNOT** be counted for Faculty Professional Development/FLEX credit:

- 1. Preparation required to teach or perform the services on a day-to-day basis, such as writing syllabi, reading and/or grading of student papers, preparing class lectures or handouts.
- 2. Activities for which a faculty member receives compensation
- 3. Fundamental requirements as outlined in a SMC FA Contract faculty job description (FA Contract FACULTY ASSIGNMENT AND LOAD: 6.1 Duties of Assignment)
- 4. The portion of an activity (such as attendance at conferences, seminars, presentations, or visits to business or commercial sites) that <u>conflicts</u> with hours scheduled <u>during</u> normal assignment and/or class hours/office hours; If an activity overlaps with assigned teaching hours, only those portions that do not overlap may be used to fulfill Flex Hours
- 5. Travel time to and from conferences and meetings
- 6. Moving, painting, cleaning or reorganizing office furniture or files
- 7. Evaluation of faculty within your department
- 8. For full time faculty, attending Institutional Flex Day Activities or Department meetings; this does not apply to part time faculty- part time faculty <u>may fulfill</u> INDIVIDUAL Professional Development /FLEX credit by attending these institutionalized activities and meetings.
