CONSTITUTION CHANGES

beginning SPRING 2012

(revised 2/13/12)

1. CLUB CONTINUATION (fall to spring only):

ARTICLE II, SECTION 3: CLUB CONTINUATION

Ongoing clubs shall be required to submit a confirmation of any officers continuing in the same positions, including Advisors, and a change of officer form for any new officers, to be verified by the ICC Advisor.

Ongoing clubs shall retain their recognized status in the ICC so long as these forms are received by the ICC Advisor by or before the third (3) week of the semester. If these forms are not submitted by the deadline, the club shall be subject to reformation.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

Basically, fall semester clubs that ended in “good standing,” will submit the new form- ICC CLUB CONTINUATION FORM & new officer/advisor ICC Orientation Quiz results. See box below taken from the continuation packet- A.S. Website, “Forms & Documents,” ICC CLUB CONTINUATION PACKET.

ICC Club Continuation information – Spring Semester 2012:

IF your club was installed in the Fall 2011 Semester AND is in good standing (has NOT been terminated) your club may qualify to use the NEW ICC Club continuation form for Spring 2012.

- Submit your completed forms to the AS Office anytime within the first 3 weeks of the spring semester (2/13/2012 – 3/1/2012.) AND attend the upcoming spring ICC Meetings.
- ALL NEW OFFICERS & ADVISORS (President, Delegates, Liaisons) MUST complete the online ICC Orientation AND pass the orientation quiz (available in the AS Office), BEFORE your club will be considered for club continuation.
- Upon verification of officers & advisor(s) your club will be recognized and receive a club meeting room, funding & services.
- After March 1st clubs MUST use the regular ICC Club registration packet.

2. CLUB ICC REPRESENTATIVES (changed to one Club Delegate):

ARTICLE II, SECTION 4: CLUB REPRESENTATION

The Membership of the ICC shall consist of: up to one (1) representative from each recognized Associated Student organization (club) and the three ICC officers.

There shall be one (1) designated representative from each club: the club’s President or his/her delegate. If the President is not in attendance, he/she shall appoint a delegate from among his/her club’s officers, as defined in their club’s constitution. An officer who is also a voting member of the Associated Students Board of Directors is not eligible to be appointed a delegate.

All representatives will be registered with the ICC.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN for ALL CLUBS?

- Instead of two club ICC REPRESENTATIVES, there is now one DELEGATE;
- The Club President is automatically the Delegate;
- If the President cannot act as the Delegate, s/he must appoint one from the registered club officers.
