

What Respiratory Therapists Do

Respiratory therapists care for patients who have trouble breathing—for example, because of a chronic condition such as asthma.

How to Become One

Work Environment

Most respiratory therapists work full time. Because they may work in medical facilities that are always open, such as hospitals, they may have shifts that include nights, weekends, or holidays.

How to Become a Respiratory Therapist

Respiratory therapists typically need an associate's degree in respiratory therapy. Some employers prefer to hire candidates who have a bachelor's degree. Respiratory therapists must be licensed in all states except Alaska; requirements vary by state.

Pay

The median annual wage for respiratory therapists was \$61,830 in May 2021.

Respiratory Care: Program Information

- Prepares students to take examinations:
 - TMC: Therapist Multiple Choice Examination
 - CSE: Clinical Simulation Exam
 - Passing both exams awards the graduate the RRT (registered respiratory therapist) credential
 - RRT credential is required for licensure in the State of California

Graduates will receive eligibility to sit for other specialized exams such as:

- Certified Pulmonary Function Technologist
- Registered Pulmonary Function Technologist
- Neonatal/Pediatric Respiratory Care Specialist
- Sleep Disorders Testing and Therapeutic
 Intervention Respiratory Care Specialist

Respiratory Care Program Prerequisites

-Reflective of prerequisites as outlined in Fall 2022 Respiratory Care Degree Audit and Program Map
-Completion of Respiratory Care Program Prerequisite courses with grade C or better
Requirements for admission are subject to change.

Respiratory Care Program Prerequisites (effective Fall 2022)

- CHEM 19 (preferred) or CHEM 10 (5 semester units)
- ANATMY 1 (4 semester units): Prerequisite ENGL1
- □ PHYS 3 (4 semester units): Prerequisites (CHEM 19 or CHEM 10) & ANATMY 1
- □ MCRBIO 1 (5 semester units): Prerequisites (CHEM 19 or CHEM 10) & PHYS 3
- HEALTH 61 (3 semester units)

*Starting Fall 2022, the SMC Respiratory Care program will resume requiring science prerequisite courses (Chemistry 19 or Chemistry 10, Human Anatomy, Human Physiology, and Microbiology) be completed with an on-ground lab. Science prerequisite courses completed fall 2022 or later are required to have an on-ground lab.

For prerequisite waivers for courses completed at other colleges/universities:

- Connect with a SMC Counselor for <u>prerequisite waiver</u> to enroll into ENGL 1, ANATMY 1
- Connect with the SMC <u>Life Science Department</u> for prerequisite waiver to enroll into PHYS 3, MCRBIO 1

To transfer courses completed at other colleges/universities or AP exam scores:

- Request official transcript(s) and/or AP Score Report be sent to SMC Admissions & Records Office
- Connect with a Health Sciences Counselor regarding "Transcript Evaluation for GE's"
 - Transcript Evaluation Request: course description required, course syllabus recommended.
- Connect with a Health Sciences Counselor regarding "(Major) Course Substitution/ Equivalence Request"
 - (Major) Course Substitution/Equivalence Request: Provide course description and course syllabus.

- SMC student ID# for needed for application to be processed.
- Official transcripts from other colleges/universities must be on file with SMC Admissions and Records Office.
- AP college credit: request the College Board send an official AP score report to SMC Admissions and Records Office if you received a 3 or better on an AP high school exam.
- Prerequisite and major courses completed at other institutions may require additional documentation such as a course syllabus.
- Schedule a counseling appointment with a SMC Health Sciences
 Counselor if you have questions.

RC Clinical Site Information

- Applicants for the program must have a negative/clear criminal background check and pass a drug screening procedure to participate in any clinical classes.
- Competency-based model.
- Varying clinical experiences.
- Opportunity to be on different floors & exposure to difference scenarios such as ER, Trauma, Pediatric.
- Generally scheduled 2x a week, 12-hour shifts.
- Paired with a Respiratory Care Practitioner, conducting a variety of treatment modalities under their supervision.
