


OUR VISION

AltaSea Progress by the Numbers

•\$7m invested to date in facility improvements

- o 180,00sf roof; 2.2 mw of solar; ADA-compliant restrooms; 3 marine labs
- •\$28m raised to complete core/shell renovation of Berths 58, 59, 60 by April 2024
 - o \$28m to date thanks to: \$15m state; \$7m private donors; \$6m POLA
 - Fiscally self-sustaining and operating at a net profit by the end of 2023
 - New \$88m capital campaign underway to renovate Berth 57 (target completion 2025)
 - Over 140 partners including 60 researchers and bluetech companies
 - o 130,000sf sf committed with over \$1m in annual rent revenues
