COURSE SEQUENCING CHART

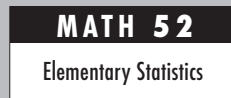
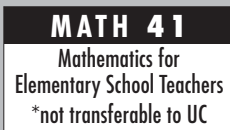
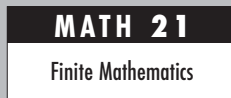
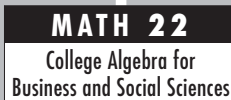
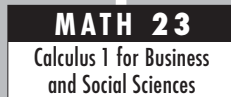
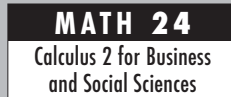
The Math Assessment process as described in the Admission section of the Schedule of Classes determines initial student placement in the math sequence.

**These courses may be taken in any order after completion of Math 8; however, students are advised to complete Math 11 and Math 15 before enrolling in Math 13.



College Level

UC and CSU require at least one college level math class for a Bachelor's degree. Specific majors may require additional math.



SMC AA Degree Level

For an AA degree, SMC requires successful completion of Math 20 or the passage of the SMC Math Proficiency Test *plus* successful completion of one additional non-math course.

Pre-College Level

Math 81, 84, 31, and 32, (as well as Math 20) will not transfer to the UC and CSU systems but are prerequisites for college level math courses and some courses in other departments.

***Sequence to Math 2**
Students preparing for Math 2 need both Math 20 and Math 32. The courses may be taken in any order or concurrently. Alternatively a student may complete Math 22 and Math 32 in any order or concurrently.
