2. Discussion

High School Articulation – Receiving College Credit for HS Coursework

Esau reviewed the points that were agreed upon by the Committee 2 weeks ago. Further discussion followed. Ron met with Estela Narrie, the articulation counselor; she and Ron would prefer to see the transcript annotated “credit by exam”. The following additions/changes were made:

4. If the articulated courses meet certificate, major, or general education requirements for the SMC AA degree, we would allow students to apply the unit credit accordingly. However, said credit may not be transferable.

#5 Students can challenge by exam only once. The student needs to have earned a grade of C or higher and needs to be recommended by a high school instructor in order to take the credit by exam. The SMC course will be listed as credit by exam.
