This regulation is a greatly revised version of AR 4446. Senators raise questions about the meaning of "outside group" and control over who can serve as a primary advisor "designee." Senators also raise free speech concerns.

vii. AR 4000 Catalog Rights 1st Read

Changes to regulation, previously AR 4351, follow more closely with Title 5 and make it easier for students to maintain enrollment.
