Whereas 17.8 million Californians cast their votes in the 2020 General Election which was the largest voter turnout in almost 70 years,

Whereas on July 1, 2021, Lieutenant Governor Kounalakis ordered a statewide election be held to determine whether to recall Governor Newsom and, if appropriate, elect a successor,

Whereas a Gubernatorial Recall Election has been set for September 14, 2021, as authorized by section 11020 California Elections Code,

Whereas every registered voter in California received a vote-by-mail ballot in this recall,

*Resolved,* that the Academic Senate of Santa Monica College calls on the college community to engage in this recall election and participate in the democratic process.
