- Please schedule your first meeting with your professor *within the first two weeks of the semester. If for any reason you are unable to accomplish this task, please notify me.*
- Meet with *your* SI professor ***regularly throughout the semester*** to ensure *you* build and maintain your professor's support.

Please make sure to ask the following questions:

1. What is your advice on the most successful study strategies for this course?
2. What is your opinion regarding the use of old tests/handouts in the SI session?
3. What are some things you specifically **want me** to emphasize during the SI sessions?
4. What are some things you specifically **do not want me** to do during the SI sessions?
5. Can students receive credit for their weekly lab hour requirement if they attend SI sessions (if applicable)? If so, are there things I should remind our students of during the sessions?
6. **If I need to contact you, what is the best way (e.g., email, phone, etc) to reach you?
