

Apostrophe Rules

- To show singular ownership
 Susials car, the chinia m
 - $_{\circ}$ $\,$ Example: Susie's car, the ship's mast $\,$
- To show plural ownership
 - $_{\odot}$ $\,$ Example: the sisters' bedroom, the buses' drivers
- To show contractions
 - Example: I'm (I am), should've (should have), won't (will not), she'd (she would), it's (it is)
- Apostrophes are not usually used with verbs
 - Example: He sits. NOT he sit's
- Apostrophes are not used for simple plural nouns
 - Example: Cars use gas. NOT Car's use gas.
