APPLY smc.edu/apply

Create an OpenCCC account and submit your SMC application. Once applied, an SMC ID number will be sent to your email address with next steps to set up your SMC account.



FINANCIAL AID smc.edu/financialaid

Complete a FAFSA or DREAM Act application to see if you qualify for assistance with tuition, books, and required class materials.



ORIENTATION smc.edu/orientation

First-time college students are required to complete the online orientation to enroll in classes. Log in to complete orientation using the SMC account you set up in step 1.



REVIEW COURSE PLACEMENT smc.edu/cc

View your English and Math placement levels in the Classes & Enrollment Tab in Corsair Connect. These levels help determine your readiness for certain courses.



COUNSELING AND MYEDPLAN smc.edu/counseling

Meet with a counselor to assist you with your educational plan, course selections, transfer questions, and to learn about campus resources.

Apply for Financial Aid

Step 1: Apply

FAFSA (U.S. Citizens & Eligible Non-Citizens)

- Fill out the **FAFSA** (Free Application for Federal Student Aid): [FAFSA.gov](https://fafsa.gov)
- The FAFSA determines your eligibility for Federal, State, and Institutional aid
- **FAFSA school code: 001286**

DREAM ACT (AB540 students)

- Undocumented students who meet AB540 requirements must submit an AB540 affidavit
- AB540 students complete the Dream Act Application: [DREAM.csac.ca.gov](https://dream.csac.ca.gov)
- The Dream Act application determines your eligibility for State and Institutional Aid
- **DREAM ACT school code: 00128600**

*The **priority deadline** for both applications is **March 2**.

SCHOLARSHIPS

- Apply to SMC Foundation Scholarships at smc.edu/scholarships

Step 2: Check Your Financial Aid Portal

- Log in to Corsair Connect and select Financial Aid to find your Financial Aid portal
- Review pending requirements; requested documents can be uploaded to Corsair eDocs
- Once requirements are complete, the review process can take 4-6 weeks
- Awards can be viewed in your portal once the review process is complete

QUICK TIPS

- Apply for financial aid early to be considered for maximum aid; if you miss the priority deadline, you may still qualify!
- Aid is awarded on an annual basis. Get in the habit of re-applying for aid every year by the March 2 priority deadline.
- Get help with the financial aid process by visiting or contacting the SMC Financial Aid office.

SPRING & FALL SEMESTERS

16 weeks

WINTER & SUMMER SESSIONS

6 weeks (instruction is 3x as fast)

KEY TERMS

Prerequisite: a course or skill level that MUST be completed or in progress before enrolling in the next level.

Skills Advisory: a course or skill level that should be completed or in progress before enrolling—but is NOT REQUIRED.

FINDING CLASSES

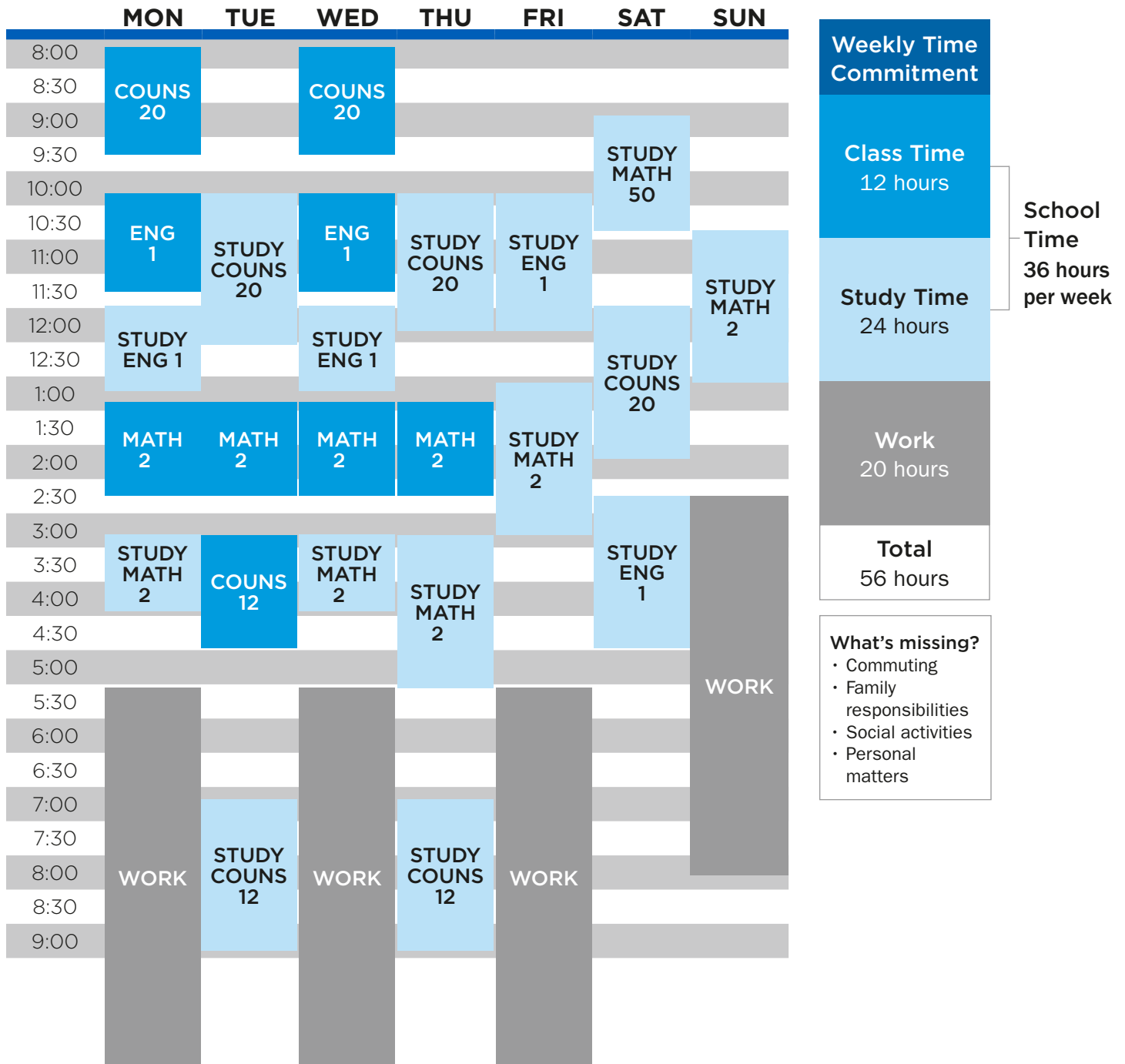

Full-time student with part-time job.

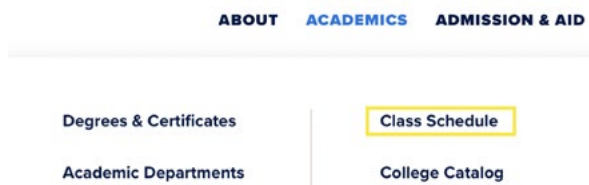

Prerequisite/Advisory	Transfer: UC, CSU Advisory: Art 10A.
Description	This course is designed to teach students basic ceramic design, materials, terminology, and construction methods, with an emphasis on building ceramic forms by hand with pinch, coil, and slab techniques. The course introduces students to the history of ceramics in a variety of cultural contexts, from ancient to contemporary. Students will have the opportunity to develop unique sculptural and functional ceramic objects with a wide variety of construction and decoration techniques.

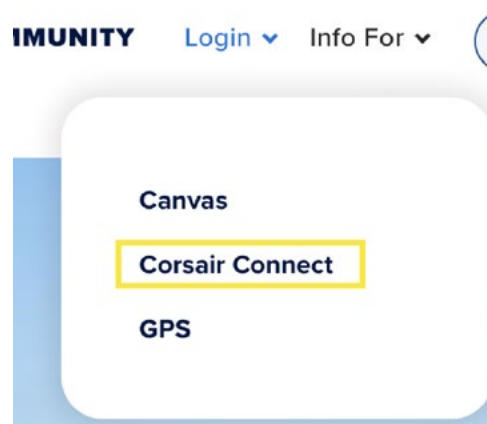


ACCESSING CORSAIR CONNECT

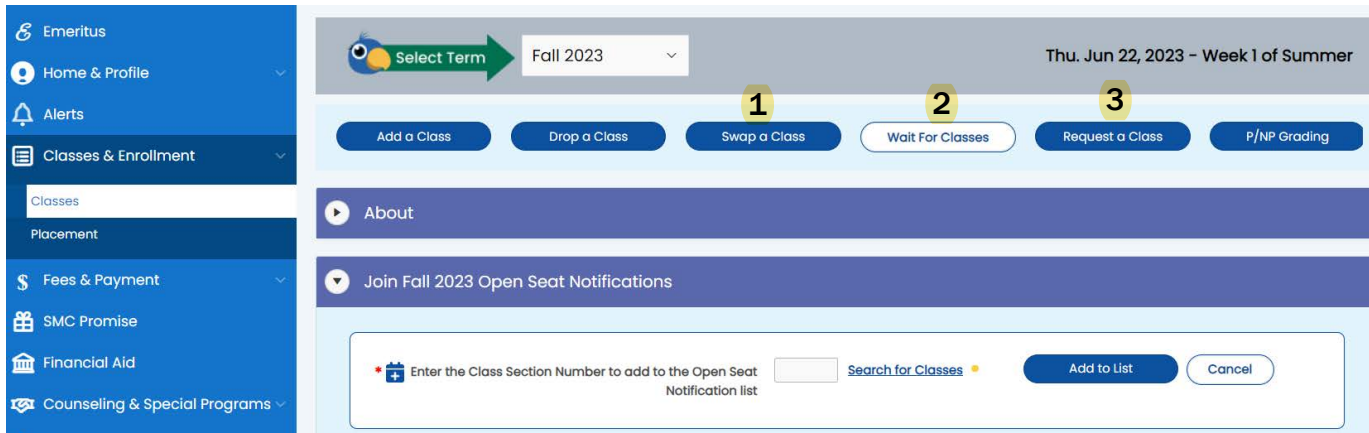

Use these tips when classes are closed.



DURING ENROLLMENT PERIOD

1 Swap a Class

When you find another section with an open seat and want to drop a course you are currently enrolled, you can swap the two at the same time. This option lets you save your seat in your current class until you can be successfully added to a new one.

2 Join an Open Seat Notification List

Notifies you, and all students on the notification list, via SMC email if a seat becomes available.

3 Request a Class

You may request a class to let the college know what additional sections are desired. However, this does not mean a new class may be added.

2 WEEKS BEFORE THE SEMESTER STARTS

2 Join a Wait List

2 weeks before the semester begins, the Open Seat Notification List goes away, and students can get on a wait list. Students on the wait list must attend the first class session in order to be given first consideration in adding the class, if space is available.

Crash a Class

If a class is full, you can show up to the first class to see if the instructor will give you an approval code to add the class. You can crash as many classes as you want for the first 2 weeks of the semester. It is best to return to that same class multiple times; this improves your odds of obtaining an approval code from the instructor to add yourself to the class.

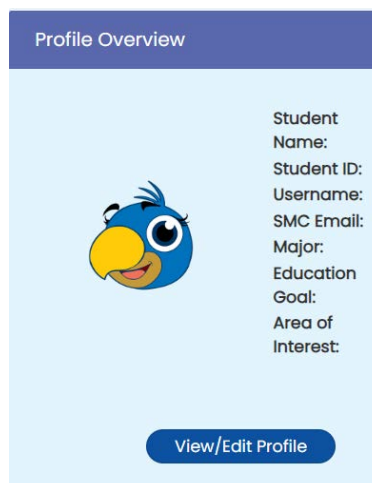
