## Registered Nursing (Associate Degree)

**STEP 1:** Access Associate Degree Nursing Program Map/Curriculum. You will need to refer to the course list for your education plan.

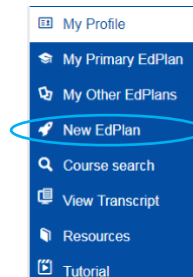
**STEP 2:** Login into your Corsair Connect at [www.smc.edu/cc](http://www.smc.edu/cc)

**STEP 3:** On left under Tools for Success, click on MyEdPlan



**STEP 4:** Create a New MyEdPlan for your Associate Degree in Nursing

- Click on **"New EdPlan"** on left
- Sign off on Agreement
- Select **Next** for the MyEdPlan Wizard
- Select "Obtain an Associate degree from SMC (no transfer plans), then click **Next**.
- Select "Nursing-RN" for general field of study and "Registered Nursing (AS)" as major concentration, then click **Next**.
- Select "Winter 2023" as your start semester if you are enrolling in additional Nursing graduation and/or AS General Education requirements (e.g., PSYCH 19, COM ST 11 or 35, Social Science Group A, Humanities, Global Citizenship) before starting the Nursing program. If you do not plan to take Winter courses, you can select "Spring 2023" as your start semester and click **Next**.



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
## Registered Nursing (Associate Degree)

- Respond to questions on Weekly and Daily Activities survey and click on **Calculate** – then click **Next**.

### STEP 5: Add Nursing Courses to your MyEdPlan

- Under the “MyEdPlan By Term” section, add the courses you will take each semester.
- Be sure to add courses for **all** four semesters of the Nursing Program **and** NURSING 36, NURSING 17, PSYCH 19, COM STUDIES 11 or 35, and SMC General Education requirements that you have not completed.
- Add NURSING 900 (Supervised Tutoring) to **EACH** semester.
- You can add General Education courses you have not completed during intersessions (Summer/Winter)

### Important Reminders


- NURSNG 36 must be completed with NURSNG 1 & NURSNG 1L.
- NURSNG 17 can be completed either 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> semester. If you did not complete PHYS 3 at SMC visit the Life Science Department webpage. You need to submit a waiver request to enroll in NURSNG 17. <https://www.smc.edu/academics/academic-departments/life-sciences/prerequisite-waivers.php>
- PSYCH 19 must be completed prior to the start of the 3<sup>rd</sup> semester.
- COM ST 11 (meets requirement if completed after summer 2013) or COM ST 35.
- NURSNG 900 (found under non-credit) course during all semesters of the Nursing program.

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### STEP 6: Check Degree Audit

Under the My Degree Audit section, check your **Major Progress**. You can expand each section to identify which requirement is missing and add the course to the appropriate semester.




