### Nursing Major Courses:

- Nursing 36 Calculations in Drugs & Solutions
  - If not yet completed, enroll in 1<sup>st</sup> 8 weeks section. This course must be completed prior to entering the 2<sup>nd</sup> 8 weeks of the 1<sup>st</sup> semester Nursing courses.
- Nursing 17 Pharmacological Aspects of Nursing
  - Enforced prerequisite: Physiology 3
  - If PHYS 3 was not completed at SMC – you will need to request a prerequisite waiver by sending an email to [ScienceWaivers@smc.edu](mailto:ScienceWaivers@smc.edu). Include your name, SMC student ID#, scanned transcripts, weblinks to official

course descriptions or course outlines, scanned syllabi (optional but recommended), and any other verification that would assist in verifying your waiver.

- If not yet completed prior or during 1<sup>st</sup> semester, it will need to be completed concurrently with 2<sup>nd</sup> semester Nursing courses.

- Nursing 900 Supervised Tutoring (FREE)
  - Provides additional assistance to nursing students through a stimulating and engaging learning environment in order to facilitate understanding and comprehension of the core concepts taught in the nursing curriculum.
