AUDITIONS

Chamber Choir is SMC'S most select choir and requires an audition. During your audition, Dr. Selvey will listen for the same requisite skills required of Concert Chorale (see information under Voice Placements for Concert Chorale), as well as your ability to demonstrate significant potential for vocal growth and development and musicianship skills (music literacy, tuning, listening, etc.).

Dr. Selvey will be listening to your range (and tone quality throughout your range), your capacity for pitch memory up to 4 sequential notes, your ability to sight read, and your ability to learn on your own a section of music without supportive resources. The combination of music reading, consistent singing tone, choral experience, and personal drive and commitment that you bring will help determine where you best fit in SMC's choral program.

REQUISITE SKILLS

In addition to the skills assessed in the audition, you must also be able and willing to practice language, notes, rhythms, vocalism, and artistry on your own outside of rehearsal to reinforce what we accomplish in the rehearsal and to learn whatever you may not have picked up in the allotted rehearsal time. This commitment typically requires 1-2 hours per week outside of rehearsals. We regularly provide online tools as well as tutoring to help you improve and become more efficient in your practice.
