ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS: Because you will be taking classes in a clinical setting you will be required to pay for a background check, drug screening and have a current CPR certification. Anticipated out of pocket expenses range from \$250-\$350. **The SPRING 2026 application deadline is Wednesday, December 31, 2025.** Beyond that date, applicants can submit their paperwork to be placed on a waiting list to be considered for the next available cohort.
