*Report from Senate/Senate Executive:*

The Senate will start discussing adding a new grade option (FW) which apply to circumstances when an F grade was earned because of non-participation in the course and not because of failing on course assessments. An FW will not change the calculation of the *course success rate metric* examined in the IEC.

Hannah Lawler shared out a change.org link organized by SMC students to create more all-gender restrooms on campus. These efforts are aligned with discussions happening in DPAC Facilities Committee. Two faculty will also make comments related to students' need for increased access to all-gender restrooms at the April Board of Trustees meeting.

**V. Old Business**  
**A. Review of IE Framework**

The Committee discussed the need to balance the number of metrics on the IE dashboard with helping the College focus on key priorities. Some suggestions to reduce the number of metrics (currently 96) to a manageable number include:

- Requesting other bodies that systemically review related metrics to provide one or two paragraphs analyzing the college’s performance to be part of the IE report (link to metrics instead). The IE report can serve as a content repository for these metrics.
  - All fiscal metrics (DPAC Budget)
  - Employee diversity report (HR)
  - Infrastructure (4.10 - 4.14 to be discussed in TPC and DPAC Facilities)
- 4.1 - 4.9 belongs in Sustainability, not IE report
- Report ACCJC metrics separately for review by IEC during the year
