

Spring 2018 Academic and Progress Probation Student Population

All Spring 2018 Probation Students

Number of Students: 1,949

- Attended summer 2018 BTS session: 622 (32%)
- Contact with counselor (appointment, drop-in, online): 299 (15%)
- Number of students that did not enroll in Fall 2018: 763 (39%)
87 (11%) of these 763 students attended a BTS session
39 (5%) of these 763 students saw a counselor

The data below is specific to the population of under-represented students who were placed on probation

Definition of under-represented: students identified themselves as Latino, Hispanic, Black, or African American

under-represented students contacted by counselors via phone (spoke to or left message about BTS)

Number of Students: 542

- Attended summer 2018 BTS session: 205 (37%)
- Contact with counselor (appointment, drop-in, online): 93 (17%)
- Number of students that did not enroll in Fall 2018: 198 (37%)
33 (17%) of these 198 students attended a BTS session
14 (7%) of these 198 students saw a counselor

under-represented students not contacted by counselors

Number of Students: 695

- Attended summer 2018 BTS session: 245 (35%)
- Contact with counselor (appointment, drop-in, online): 102 (14%)
- Number of students that did not enroll in Fall 2018: 253 (36%)
25 (10%) of these 253 students attended a BTS session
12 (5%) of these 253 students saw a counselor
