

Santa Monica College Curriculum Committee Annual Report

Over the course of the 2018-2019 academic year, the SMC Curriculum Committee held fifteen full committee meetings. The outcome of our work includes:

- 66 new courses
- 56 substantive changes to courses, including changes in the essence of the course, hours or units, major title changes, addition or deletion of elective options in programs, removal or addition of prerequisites, co-requisites, or advisories, addition, removal or revision of GE areas, discipline changes, major changes to objectives and outcomes, content / presentation / evaluation
- 35 courses adding Distance Education, including our first ever Anthropology and Kinesiology courses
- 11 courses adding Global Citizenship
- 36 new degrees/certificates
- 35 changes to degrees/certificates, including additions or deletions of courses and changes in units in degrees and certificates, changes in GE lists, updating terminology, content, disciplines and titles
- 6 courses approved for Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) and 9 approved for California State University General Education (CSUGE)
- 246 updates/non-substantial changes to courses, including changes in objectives, updated Student Learning Outcomes, content, presentation, evaluation, title, texts, etc (some came through more than once with different changes)
- 32 degrees/certificates deactivated, most due to lowering units for Certificates of Achievement
- 4 courses deactivated
- To assist faculty, created CTE Narrative Template, CTE Program Process, Non-CTE Narrative template, and updated selected areas of the Online Curriculum Handbook (Curriculum website). Updating this site is an ongoing project.

Topics of interest we explored over the year included:

Topics of interest affecting Curriculum this year included:

- lowering of units for Certificates of Achievement and the impact that had on Department Certificates
- the Redesign of the Student Experience with the changes brought forward by departments based on examining their curriculum closely during the mapping process, AB 705 and Title 5 changes. Regular updates from Redesign of the Student Experience team were given, which were presented to the Senate, and the committee and later Senate approved SMC's Areas of Interest and Academic and Career Paths (3/6/19)
- Articulation officer Estela Narrie brought forth the information that from Summer 2015 through Spring 2018 there was a 63% increase in ADTs awarded, and the number of ADTs offered rose from 15 to 20 during that same time period
- expansion of corequisite support courses for college-level English and Math courses
- the SMC GE Language and Rationality area has been updated as a result of changes to Math because of AB 705

**Students may complete this exam any time within one year of their anticipated graduation date. Note that students may retest only once, after an 8-week wait.

- the update on the noncredit curriculum approval process. In March, the Curriculum Committee of the California Community Colleges (5C) approved equalization of the approval process between credit and noncredit courses as supported by Resolution 9.02 at the Fall plenary of the Academic Senate for California Community Colleges (ASCCC) adopted November 3, 2018. 5C approved noncredit streamlining – local approval of noncredit courses and programs, with the exception of CDCP short-term vocational noncredit programs as these require Chancellor's Office approval by law. Noncredit approval streamlining still requires Board of Governors and Consultation Council approval, and will hopefully be officially announced at the 2019 summer Curriculum Institute.
- Continued exploration and creation of noncredit pathways and development of noncredit (NC) courses and certificates
- Supported SMC faculty efforts to pursue Open Education Resources (OER) and Zero Textbook Cost (ZTC) degrees for students

Ongoing areas of interest are the next phase of the Redesign, the expansion of noncredit, great development in CTE courses and programs, continuing effects of AB 705, NC, OER/ZTC, and the changing landscape among our partners in higher education.
