

Program Mapping

- Approximately 50 programs were mapped (Phase 1) during the 3 “Mapping Days” we held in Fall.
 - Feedback from these days was overwhelmingly positive.
 - In particular, the cross-communication between counseling and instructional faculty was highly valued by both of those groups.
 - Additionally, seeing the course sequence from the STUDENT PERSPECTIVE and the STUDENT’S END GOAL has caused some wonderful and needed dialogue and action to eliminate barriers.
- We will be holding 1 more Mapping Day on March 29 for about 15 programs.
- The remaining 20 programs will be mapped (Phase 1) in smaller groups (and not at a large “Mapping Day”).
- We hope to begin **Phase 2** of Program Mapping in late Spring or early Fall.
 - Just FYI: Phase 2 will be much more difficult as we consider the difficult questions of curricular reforms, student-centered/equity-minded reforms, embedded and expanded academic (and non-academic) support, cost/benefit information for students, employment and career options, ...
