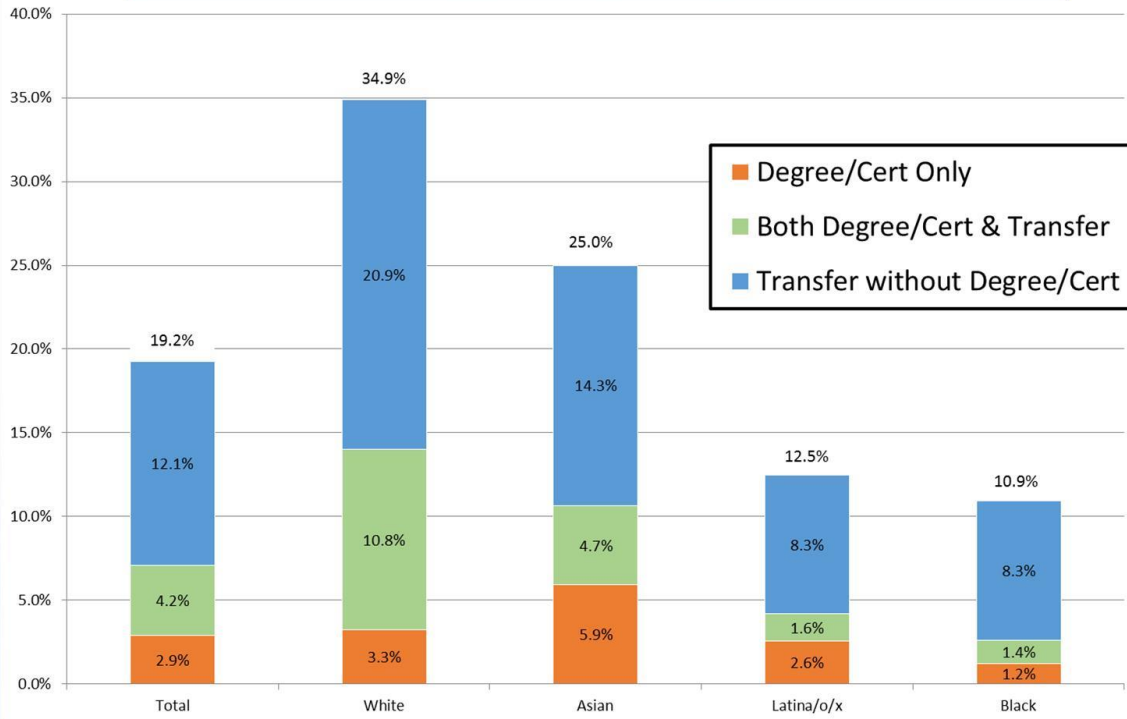


GUIDED PATHWAYS FRAMEWORK

- Developing and implementing a “guided pathways framework” at the college requires **managing and sustaining large-scale transformational change**.
- A guided pathways framework is **not** a program, an initiative, a pilot, an add-on, nor what we will “do”.
- Instead, this framework means the transformation of “business as usual”; it should be thought of as **“what we are going to become”**

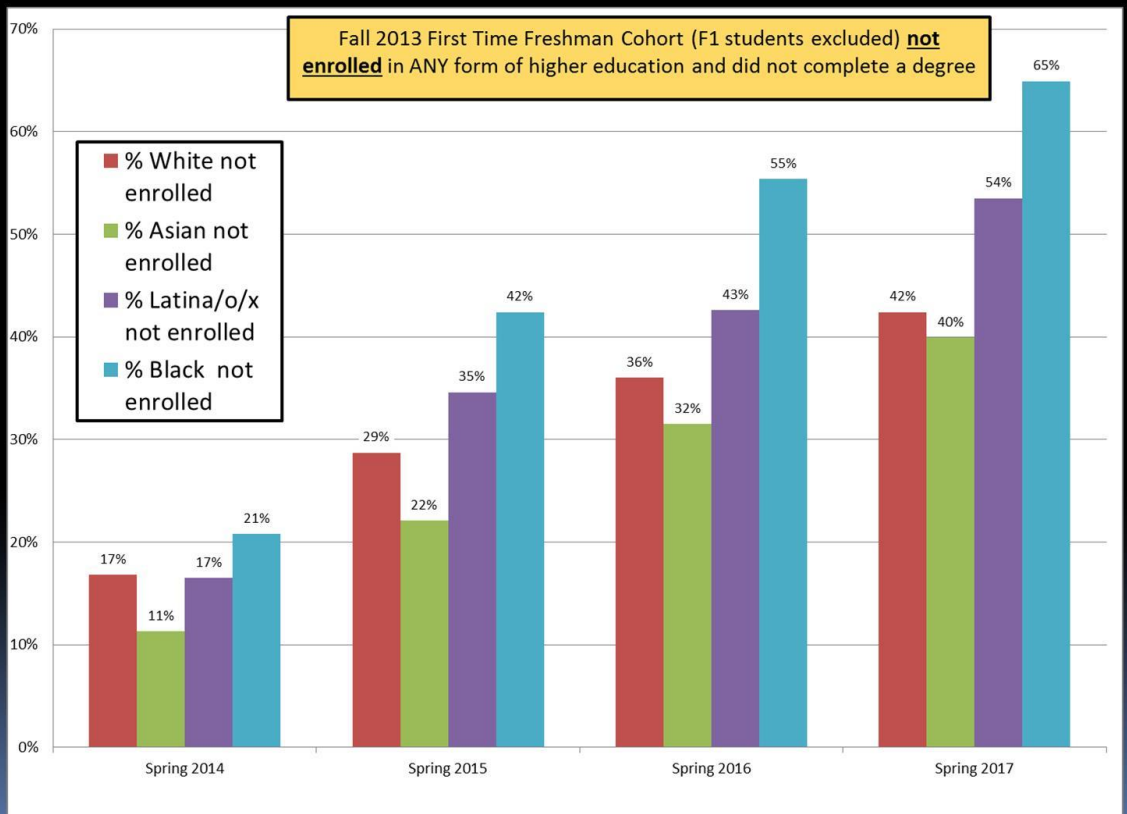
THE NEED FOR SIGNIFICANT CHANGE

Fall 2013 First-Time Freshman Cohort, F1 students excluded, achievement within 3 years (n=5022)



THE NEED FOR SIGNIFICANT CHANGE

Fall 2013 First Time Freshman Cohort (F1 students excluded) **not enrolled** in ANY form of higher education and did not complete a degree



THE NEED FOR SIGNIFICANT CHANGE
