## IV. Reports/Discussion

a. Brainstorm and Discussion on ideas to close the deficit for the 2023-2024 District Budget. Dr. Jeffery, Superintendent/President, addressed the group and asked the Budget Committee to prepare a recommendation to help the district address the deficit. The May Revise revealed that funding for Community College budgets is lower than projected and the District will need to reduce the gap in the deficit to maintain a 5% Fund Balance recommended by the Chancellor's office to pass a budget.

Chris Bonvenuto shared the Multi-Year Unrestricted General Fund-Five Year Projections, Fiscal Years 2022-2023 thru 2027-2028 showing a declining fund balance. The Budget Committee needs to act now to address the gap in the deficit to pass a budget with the recommended 5% Fund Balance for Fiscal Year 2024-2025. The Committee began its discussion regarding budget reductions. There will be a Special Budget Committee Meeting on May 24, 2023 @ 2 pm.
