



CROSS ENROLLMENT VERIFICATION FORM

CROSS ENROLLMENT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Undergraduate students enrolled in any campus of the California Community Colleges, the California State University, or the University of California may enroll without formal admission in a maximum of one course per academic term at a campus of either of the systems on a space available basis at the discretion of the appropriate campus authorities on both campuses. Enrollment in pre-collegiate courses is excluded.

A student is qualified for Cross Enrollment if the student has met all of the following requirements:

- Completed at least one term at the home campus (SMC) as a matriculated student.
- Enrolled for a minimum of six units for the current term.
- Earned grade point average of 2.00 (grade of C) for work completed.
- Paid appropriate tuition and fees at home campus for the current term.
- Completed appropriate academic preparation as determined by host campus.
- California resident.

SMC students enrolled in 6 units or more in Fall can take one course in Fall at a UC or CSU campus.

SMC students enrolled in 6 units or more in Spring can take one course in Winter or Spring Quarter at UC or CSU campus.

SMC students enrolled only in Winter intersession are not eligible for Cross Enrollment.
