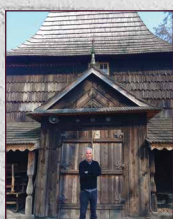


Steph Cha

Isaac Babel: New Fiction by Stephen Cooper

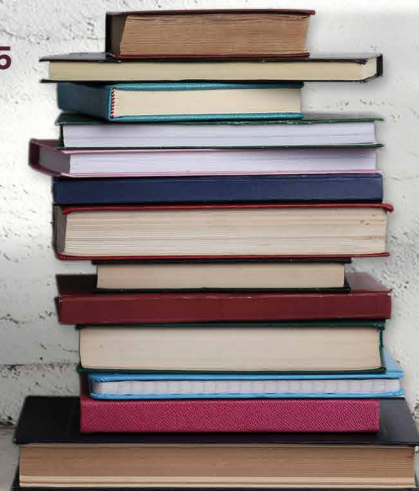
