- a. Four applications were received for global grant funding from: Keiko Tsurumi, Modern Languages, Marisol Moreno, History, Veronica Casillas, Counseling, and Jenna Gausman, Career Services Center.
- b. Following discussion of the proposals the Council voted unanimously to recommend the following Global Grants to the President/Superintendent:
 - i. Keiko Tsurumi: funding of up to \$3000 for film license for screening of film "East Side Sushi", honorariums for Director Anthony Lucero and one other panelist to be determined, and marketing.
 - ii. Marisol Moreno: funding of up to \$1000 for two guest speakers at panel discussion entitled "Transformational Resistance".
