### XI. Student Trustee Report –

- Winter 2024 Enrollment:
  - Total headcount increased by 2.20%. Credit FTES decreased by 0.74%.
  - O Non-resident FTES increased by 12.68% compared to the previous winter.
- Spring 2024 Enrollment:
  - Total headcount rose by 5.21%. Credit FTES increased by 5.84%.
  - Non-resident FTES notably grew by 11.66% compared to the prior spring.
- Projected deficits for 2024-2025:
  - Our projection: <\$37.9 billion> & LAO projection: <\$68.0 billion>
  - Declines attributed to Personal Income Tax (PIT), which constitutes 66% of State Revenue.
  - Key issue: Capital Gains dropped to 5% from 11.6%.
- Golden Globe Foundation Grants Award to SMC:
  - \$35,000 for SMC's film production program.
  - o \$20,000 renewed grant for SMC's journalism program.
