



**Guaranteed Transfer Admission Agreement
For International Students**

Santa Monica College/California State University, Chico
(Impacted majors are not covered under this agreement)

In order to benefit both California State University, Chico (CSU, Chico) and Santa Monica College (SMC), in the recruitment and retention of international students in their educational planning and the completion of a bachelor's degree, CSU, Chico and SMC commit to maintain and enhance relations between our institutions with regard to facilitating a smooth transition and guaranteed admission into a non-impacted major for all qualified* SMC international students.

CSU, Chico defines a qualified SMC international student as one who has:

- ✓ An F-1 visa.
- ✓ Completed at least 24 semester units with a grade point average of 2.0 in all transferable college coursework.
- ✓ Completed the required coursework in three fundamental areas of General Education with a grade of C or better – students must choose one in each category (A1, A2, B4) listed below.
- ✓ Completed a CSU application for admission by the application deadline (www2.calstate.edu/apply) and paid the \$55 application fee.
- ✓ Submitted official transcripts from all colleges attended.
- ✓ Submitted official secondary school transcripts (if transferring with fewer than 60 transferable units)
- ✓ Demonstrated proof of financial ability to pay for all costs of attending CSU, Chico for the first year.

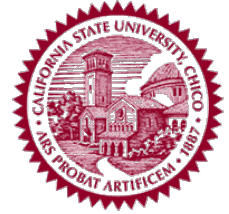
Santa Monica College

- A1: One of the following – COM ST 11, 12, 16, 21
- A2: One of the following - ENGL 1
- A4/B4: One of the following - MATH 2, 7, 8, 10, 11, 13, 15, 21, 26, 28, 29, 54; CS 10

*The qualifications for guaranteed admission to CSU, Chico (listed above) reflect CSU, Chico admission requirements for the 2017-18 academic year. In the event that CSU, Chico admission requirements change, future SMC applications to CSU, Chico will also be guaranteed admission if they meet all CSU, Chico admission requirements for their admission term. Furthermore:

- SMC will inform prospective international students of this partnership.
- SMC will provide CSU, Chico with the contact information for students who chose this program.
- SMC will send a flyer or an informal letter regarding this partnership on behalf of CSU, Chico to all international students who select this program.
- SMC agrees to include information about this partnership as well as a link to CSU, Chico on their website.



This collaboration will be in effect for five years from the date of signing. Any changes to admission requirements within the five years will necessitate immediate review of this collaboration. Either SMC or CSU, Chico can terminate this agreement at any time by providing a six (6) months advanced notice to the other Party.
