



## KEY QUESTIONS TO ASK AT A FAIR FOR NURSING MAJORS

**This list of questions ensures students get a comprehensive understanding of the Nursing program and its outcomes before making their decision!**

### PROGRAM STRUCTURE AND ADMISSIONS

- What type of Nursing degrees do you offer (BSN, RN-to-BSN, ABSN, etc.)?
- What are the admission requirements (prerequisite courses, minimum GPA, entrance exams)?
- Do you require the **TEAS, HESI, or other entrance exams**? If so, what is the minimum score?
- How competitive is the program? What is the acceptance rate?
- How many students are admitted per cohort?
- How often do you admit students (once a year, multiple times a year)?
- Are there any recency or repetition policies for prerequisite courses?
- Is there a waitlist for admission? If so, how long is it typically?

### PROGRAM DETAILS AND CURRICULUM

---

- How long does it take to complete the program once admitted?
- Is the program full-time, part-time, or both?
- What clinical experiences are included in the program? Where do students complete their clinicals?
- Does the program offer any **specializations** or focus areas?
- What is the **NCLEX-RN pass rate** for your graduates?
- Can students work while completing the program?
- Are there **online, hybrid, or in-person** course options?

## SUPPORT AND OPPORTUNITIES

---

- What kind of academic support and tutoring services do you provide for nursing students?
- Do you offer internships, job placements, or partnerships with hospitals?
- What kind of simulation labs and hands-on training facilities do you have?
- Is there an honors program or research opportunities for Nursing students?
- Are there student organizations or mentorship programs for Nursing students?

## COST AND FINANCIAL AID

---

- What is the total estimated cost of the program (tuition, fees, supplies, etc.)?
- Are there specific **scholarships, grants, or financial aid** options available for Nursing students?
- Do you offer work-study or paid clinical opportunities?

## POST-GRADUATION AND CAREER SUPPORT

---

- What percentage of your graduates pass the **NCLEX-RN** on the first try?
- What percentage of graduates find jobs within **six months to a year** after graduating?
- Do you provide career counseling or job placement assistance?
- Do you have partnerships with hospitals or healthcare organizations for job opportunities?
