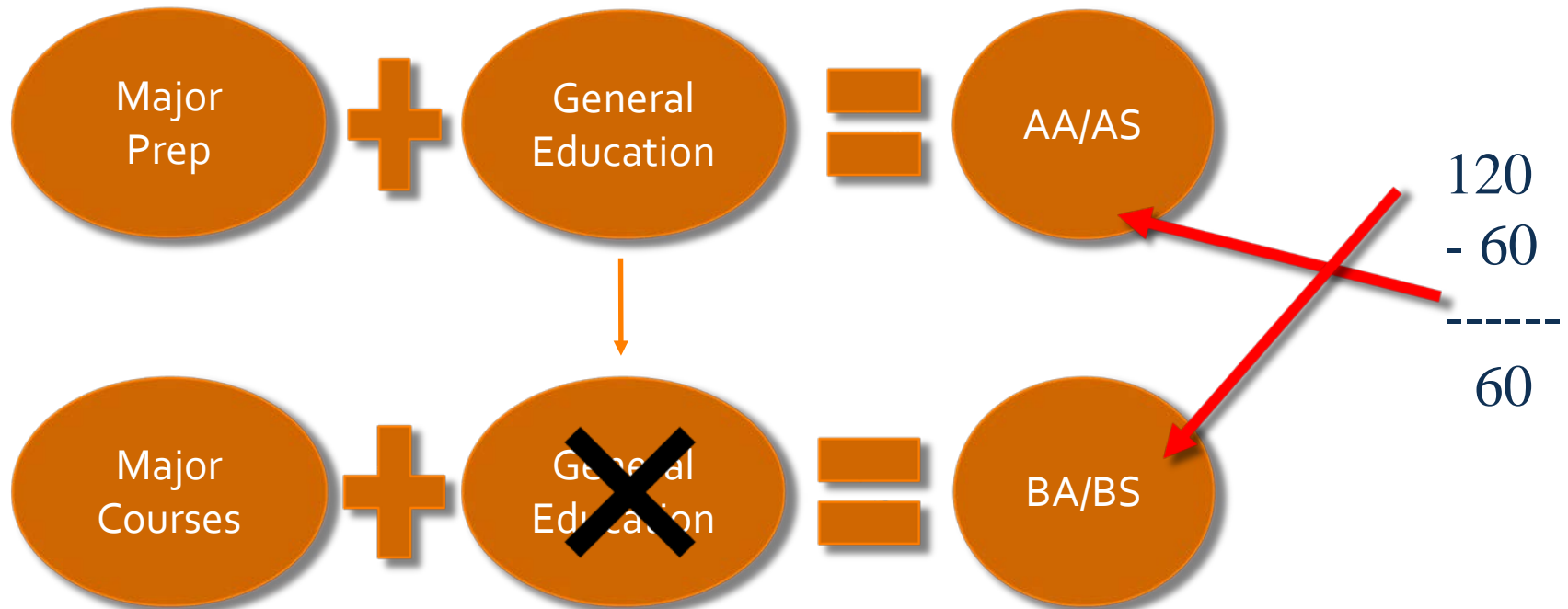


The UC

- Research and Theory Focused
- Full-time
- Tuition: \$13,900 per year (residents) \$42,900 per year (non-residents)
- Application Fee: \$70

Structure of a Bachelor's Degree

Associate's Degree = 60 semester units or more



Bachelor's Degree = ~120 semester units

Minimum UC Admission Requirements

- + 60 UC transferable semester units
- + At least a 2.4 GPA, California Residents
- + At least a 2.8 GPA, Non-California Residents
- + 7 Course Pattern: Must be completed Spring before Fall transfer with a C or better
 - + 2 English- Eng 1 and Eng 2 or Hist 47
 - + 1 Math- 2, 4, 7, 8, 10, 11, 13, 15, 21, 26, 28, 29, or 54
 - + 4 Courses- Chosen from at least 2 of the areas below:
 - + Arts and Humanities
 - + Social and Behavioral Sciences
 - + Physical and Biological Sciences

*All courses must be UC transferable

Transfer Tips

- + Focus on Major Preparation Requirements
 - + Have these completed by the end of Fall prior to transfer
 - + I.e. The same semester your application is due
 - + Explore each campus and major for specifics on courses you need to complete before transfer

IGETC

- ☐ Must have “C” or better
- ☐ Recommend completion prior to transfer.
- ☐ Equivalency of course work from other schools **must be approved by a counselor**
- ☐ Foreign course work cannot be used
- ☐ Student must apply for certification
- ☐ See IGETC handout for exceptions

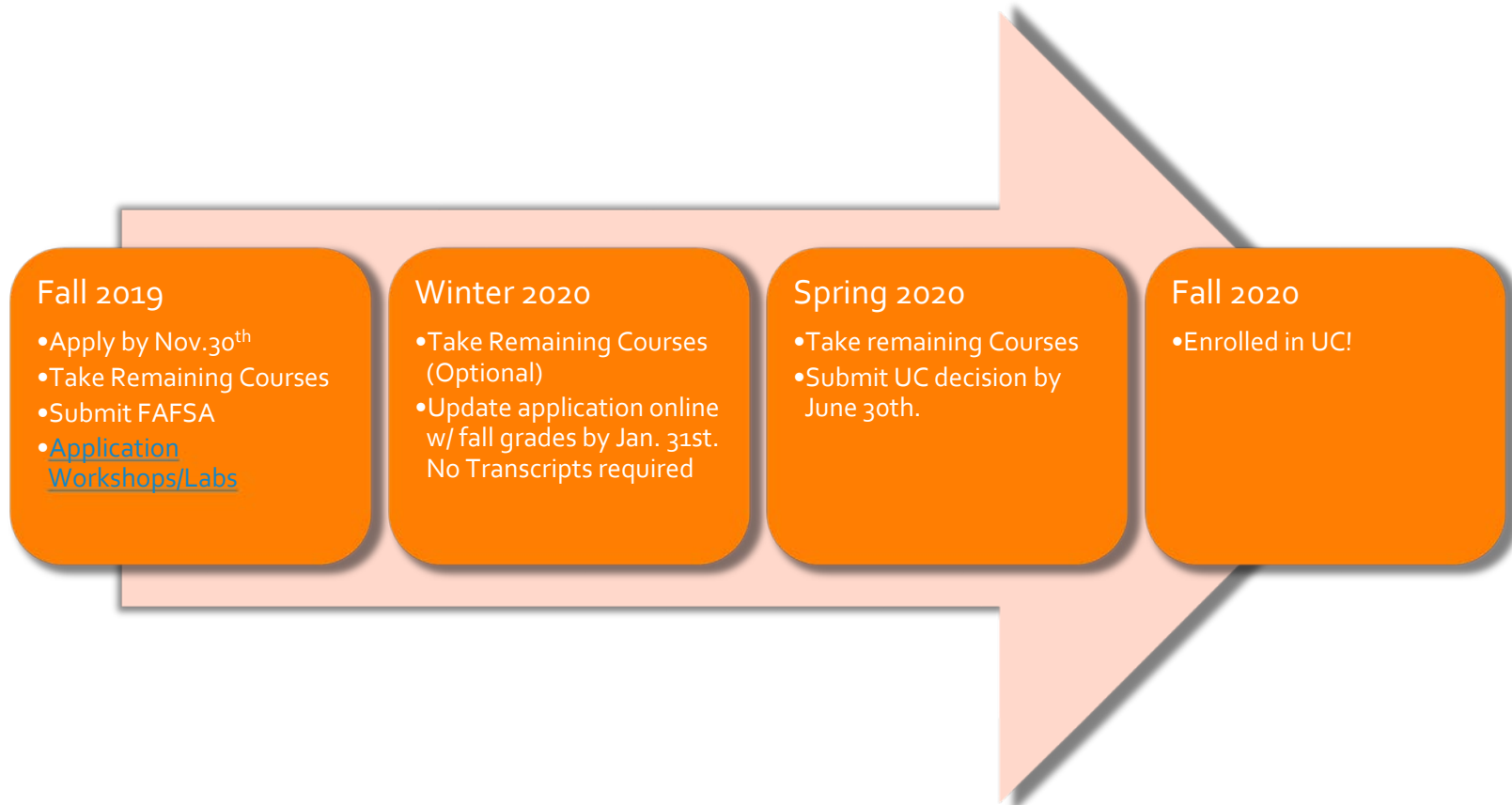


Application Filing Periods

- + Fall application opens August 1st
- + Application submission begins November 1st
- + Application deadline is November 30th

- + Winter and Spring Applications Vary
- + Not all campuses open for Winter and Spring Admissions

*By the end of spring student will meet min. UC admission requirements, as much major preparation as possible, completed IGETC certification petition, and sent official transcripts to the UC.



UC Berkeley

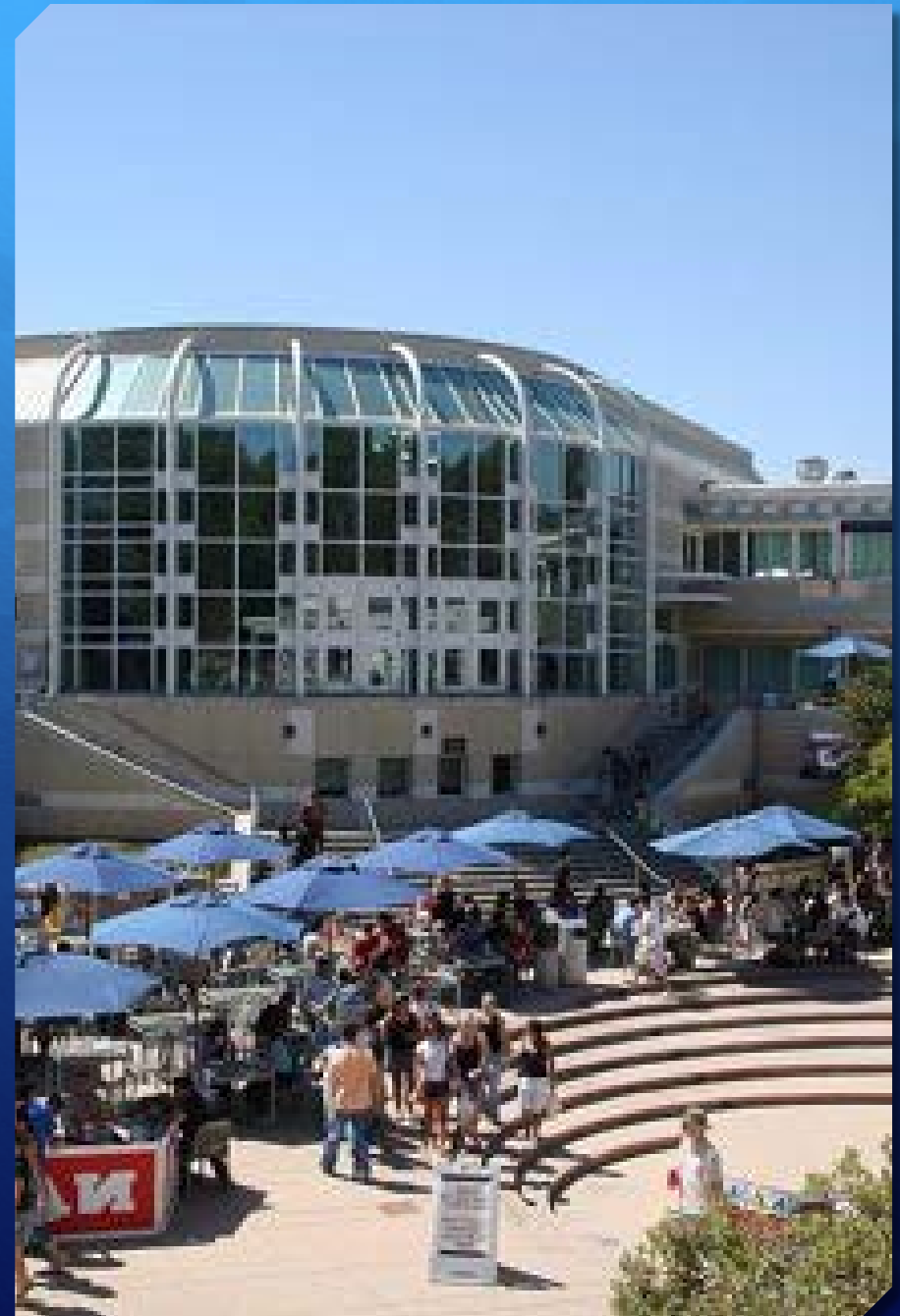

Final Transfer Tips...

- All U.S. and foreign college and university course work **must be reported** on the admissions application
- Complete minimum admissions requirements especially in English and math, as soon as possible.
- Aim to complete sequences at one campus:
 - (eg: Physics 21,22,23) prior to transfer
- Apply to several campuses!
 - Give yourself options!
